

## PARISH COUNCIL REPORT JULY / AUGUST

### THEFT OTHER

#### GREAT BUDWORTH:

Report of pedal cycle stolen from outside the pub at the Cock O Budworth - the bike was later found by Police from the South Yorks area. The bike had a tracker on it.

#### WINCHAM:

Report of portable speaker stolen from a bag whilst visiting Pickmere Lake on 29/7/24.  
No one has captured the offence taking place.

### CRIMINAL DAMAGE

#### BARNTON:

Report of shed window broken in the early hours on 11/7/24 - no CCTV no one has seen or heard anything at time of offence. Street a week was conducted to see if residents had any information and to make them aware of incident reported.

#### WINCHAM:

Report of a large fire on private land leading to Pickmere Lake on 29/7/24 - no CCTV at the location  
On speaking to farmer there was approximately two acres of damage caused. Fire have attended and put fire out. The area has been monitored on a regular basis. Community knife sweep took place last week, no knives or sharps found. A community litter pick is planned for 13/08/24 from 2pm

#### WINCHAM:

Report of youths on Farmers field off Earles Lane trying to light fires. Police have attended the location. On arrival no one was seen to be causing any offences.

### SHOPLIFTING OFFENCES:

#### WINCHAM:

Report of alcohol being stolen from Spar garage on 29/7/24 - CCTV has captured offence. Males have attended the shop with helmets on at time of offence.

### SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY:

#### LITTLE LEIGH:

Report of youths seen jumping of the bridge at Acton Bridge - Police have arrived and have been met by someone working on the bridge at the time - they have mentioned that they have not seen or heard anything.

#### ANDERTON:

Report of suspicious vehicle on Anderton Nature car park - vehicle was issued a CPN Community Protection Notice - the vehicle has now moved from the location.

#### BARNTON:

Leighs Brow - Report of youths smashing window to empty property. On police arrival, search made, no trace.

Whitehall Close: early hours, unknown person heard trying door handle to access a residential property.

Runcorn Road: Report of unknown male in garden at 23:56 hours, police attended, search made, no trace.

#### COMBERBACH:

Broadacre area: unknown male seen driving around location, acting suspiciously at 22:00 hours. No further reports received, nothing of note in location

Report of email believed to have been hacked regarding transfer of apple gift cards.
